Summary

Review Board staff joined with staff of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada for a site visit to the proposed Prairie Creek Mine on September 29, 2008. The site visit started in Fort Simpson around 11:20am and flew over the South Nahanni River and up Prairie Creek to the mine site. On the ground activities occurred between 12:30 and 5:00 pm. They included a visit to the existing mill, water management facilities, proposed waste rock pile location and a drive a short distance along the winter road. The flight back to Fort Simpson followed a portion of the Prairie Creek Mine winter road and flew over the vicinity of the proposed Tetcela Transfer Facility.
