Re: Notice of Referral to Environmental Assessment – Canadian Zinc Corporation, Prairie Creek Mine

This is to notify you that on August 8, 2008, Indian and Northern Affairs Canada, as per Section 126(2)(a) of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act (MVRMA)*, referred Canadian Zinc Corporation's Prairie Creek Mine proposed development to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (the Review Board) for an environmental assessment. The referral specifically identified all the activities and physical works related to water license and land use permits MV2008L2-0002, MV2008D0014, MV2008T0012 and MV2008T0013 as being part of the referred development. Indian and Northern Affairs referred this proposed development to environmental assessment on its own behalf and based in addition on a request from the Nahanni Butte Dene Band, on the grounds this development might cause a significant adverse impact on the environment.

The proposed development is now under environmental assessment, as required by s. 126(1) of the MVRMA. As required under Section 118(1) of the MVRMA, no permit or other authorization required for development under territorial or federal law can be issued until the environmental assessment is concluded.

The Review Board will create a public registry for this file, where all pertinent information will be held. The public registry will be available online at www.mveirb.nt.ca/registry. Details of the assessment process are described in the Review Board's Environmental Impact Assessment Guidelines, available online at www.mveirb.nt.ca. Information on past environmental assessments is available on the same site.

The Review Board will determine the scope of the development and the scope of assessment in consultation with interested parties. Further instructions will be provided in short order.

Attached to this letter is an application to stay on the distribution list for this environmental assessment.
