Subject: Project Description

Preamble

On April 14, 2011 the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board referred the land use permit application (MV2011C0002) for diamond exploration operation to the Review Board to conduct an environmental assessment. It has come to the Review Board's attention that the project description contained in the Land Use Permit Application may no longer be accurate.

Request

Please provide an updated Project Description that includes:

- All project information details provided in the LUP application to the MVLWB dated February 9, 2011 and letter dated February 25, 2011;
- Any and all changes to the proposed project since the submission of the LUP application;
- A 1:50000 scale map and a detailed camp site map;
- A plain language summary of the development that is appropriate for distribution at a community information session;
- Any commitments that the developer is considering to address concerns raised by parties;
 and
- Consideration of how concerns raised by parties in earlier Shoreline Zone EAs might be relevant to this project.

Project Description Format:

- All information should be contained in one document i.e., already submitted documents may be referenced but should not be amended and/or re-submitted in the place of a new document;
- The project description should be submitted electronically and in hard copy; and
- Maps should be to acceptable cartographic standards, including at a minimum a title, legend, scale, North Arrow and legible labels, as appropriate.
