Re: BHP Community Visits and Regional Meeting

Further to your letters of early September, our memo of September 8th 1999, and subsequent telephone calls; this letter is to confirm that the Dogrib Treaty 11 Council would be pleased to meet with your representatives to hear your presentations on:

- 1. The 1998 Socio-Economic Report.
- 2. The 1998 Environmental Report.
- 3. BHP's proposal to create three new mines in the Lac de Gras region.

The third presentation should only be viewed as a preliminary description of the work that BHP wishes to carry out, and further consultation will be required before the Dogib are in a position to give their opinions on the proposed project. These consultations will be a part of a new environmental assessment process that the Dogib will be requesting.

BIIP originally proposed a series of community visits, however, the Dogrib Chiefs have requested a regional meeting; this will be a much more appropriate forms for discussion on the above items.

The Dogrib Treaty 11 Council is therefore requesting that BHP commit cowards the costs of hosting this meeting. For these monies, the Dogrib Treaty 11 Council will make all arrangements necessary for this meeting.
