Re: Environmental Impact Review of Proposed DeBeers Gahcho Kué Diamond Mine

The Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board (MVEIRB) ordered an Environmental Impact Review for the proposed Gahcho Kué diamond mine at Kennady Lake on June 12, 2006. The developer, DeBeers Canada Mining Ltd., applied to the NWT Supreme Court for a judicial review of this order. On April 13, 2007 the NWT Supreme Court rendered its decision, upholding the MVEIRB's order.

The MVEIRB is now proceeding with the environmental impact review and is in the process of selecting and appointing a review panel. The *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* requires the preparation of a terms of reference for the review panel. A draft terms of reference is attached to this letter for your review. Comments should be submitted to Mary Tapsell, Manager of EIA (mtapsell@mveirb.nt.ca or fax (867) 766-7074) by May 18, 2007. A draft terms of reference for the developer's environmental impact statement and a work plan for the impact review will be distributed at a later date
