RE: Pine Point Mine Project Environmental Assessment – Rescheduling a Public Scoping Meeting in Fort Resolution

Dear President Cardinal,

Review Board staff spoke with Shawn McKay in your office last week about rescheduling the community scoping meeting for the environmental assessment of the Pine Point Mine Project. We would like to arrange an online public meeting that satisfies Covid protocols in Fort Resolution and keeps people safe.

Shawn and Board staff discussed the following logistics for the community scoping meeting:

- Online public meeting – the one-day meeting will be virtual only with Review Board staff participating remotely using Zoom.
- Date and time – please suggest a date(s) within the following time blocks. May 25-28 or May 31 – June 4, except for June 3 which has been selected by Katl’odeeche First Nation
- Coordinated meeting – **meeting date and time coordinated between all groups in Fort Resolution**, including Fort Resolution Metis Government, Deninu Kué First Nation, and the Hamlet of Fort Resolution
- Location – 2 locations, including the Community Centre in Fort Resolution as well as the Mission Island meeting hall.
- Participants – Community Centre can host up to 25 people to meet GNWT COVID restrictions. Both afternoon and evening meetings are proposed.
- Equipment – We can assist with providing equipment if needed.

We have created an online poll for this meeting to select a date. The link for the poll is in the email that accompanies this letter. Please use the link to select multiple dates if possible that would work for you. The Review Board will then pick a date for the public community scoping meeting.
