Here's a quick map showing the Dehcho-Tlicho boundary that was negotiated in 2003 in red. The Mackenzie Bison Sanctuary is outlined in Green.

The maps from True North safaris is confusing as it shows the boundary of Wildlife Management Unit "R" which is *not* the same as the Dehcho-Tlicho boundary. The "Wekheezhii" boundary is listed in the legend on this map but the line does not appear on the map itself.

With regard to the Interim Measures Agreement provisions Section 60-63, I checked to see if there were any existing land withdrawals in the area, but they are further south. However, Birch Lake is a proposed Conservation Zone in the draft Dehcho Land Use Plan, so Fort Providence would be concerned about that.
